
## **Re: Review of Draft Nunavut Water Regulations**

On August 26<sup>th</sup>, the Kitikemot Inuit Association (KitIA) presented a written submission detailing issues of concern with respect to the draft Water Regulations. On behalf of the Kivalliq Inuit Association (KivIA), I am writing to you to confirm that we fully support the comments made by KitIA in their submission.

KivIA is particularly concerned about the “double bonding” issue and believe that this is something that needs urgent and serious attention. Over the last several years, a significant amount of energy has gone into efforts to resolve this issue – or at least find a workable way around the problem – but we have been unsuccessful in our discussions with AANDC. We urge you to give serious consideration to this issue and the comments made by KitIA in their submission as a whole.
