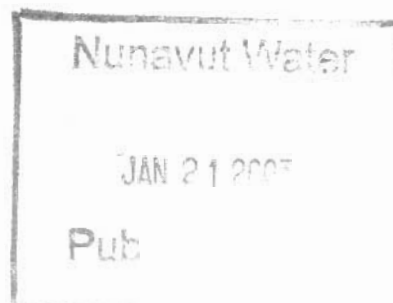

Thank you for your email of January 4th, 2003. This response is provided on behalf of the Government of Nunavut, with respect to the proposed schedule of submissions provided by Breakwater Resources Ltd. regarding their License NWB1NAN0208.

Subject to the following conditions, the Government of Nunavut would have no objection to the schedule of submissions and activities proposed by Breakwater Resources Limited:

- Breakwater provides or has provided the Security required by NWB in License NWB1NAN0208, in a form that is effective and certain for the duration of the license; and
- Appropriate interim action is taken at the tailings disposal area, to contain the dispersal of tailings through wind, groundwater, or any other similar mechanism.

From a Health perspective, we also wish to emphasize that the proposed delivery date for the *Human Health and Ecological Risk Assessment*, January 30th, 2003, is time sensitive and of very significant interest to the Government of Nunavut. This submission should not be delayed any later than January 30th, 2003.
