Re: Request for Additional Information - License Renewal for Nanisivik Mine

During the Pre-Hearing Conference on November 28, 2008 for the renewal of Water Licence *IAR-NAN0208* (Nanisivik Mine) specific requests were made for additional information or clarity as part of the review of the submissions. To address these requests, we would like to submit the files listed below, for distribution via the NWB Public Registry. This documentation is intended to support submissions already on file with the NWB as part of the renewal process.

1. **Nanisivik Mine Reclamation Completion Report:** Provides a concise summary of all reclamation activities completed until the end of 2009. It also provides a comprehensive list of references related to the Nanisivik reclamation project including all design and as-built/ confirmatory documentation. For specific details concerning each of the reclamation measures undertaken at site, the specific references included throughout this report should be consulted. To facilitate comparison of "commitments" to "achievements", the document uses the same format as the approved 2004 Final Closure and Reclamations Plan.
2. **Nanisivik Remaining Reclamation Financials 2009:** Lists the remaining financial obligations as a January 1, 2009. In conjunction with the Mine Completion Report (above) this document will provide a basis for a reduction of the security currently held under the *Part B, Item 2* of the License
3. **Nanisivik Water Quality Monitoring Report 2008:** Includes a summary of all water quality monitoring for 2008 and an interpretation of results. Where sufficient data is available spatial and temporal trends are presented. This report also includes a summary of toxicity testing during the year.
4. **Nanisivik Proposed Geotechnical Monitoring 2009:** Presents the proposed geotechnical monitoring schedule for the post closure period (2009 – 2012) in tabular form.
5. **Nanisivik Proposed Water Quality Monitoring 2009:** Presents the proposed water quality monitoring schedule for the post closure period (2009 – 2012) in tabular form.

6. **Nanisivik Dock – Contaminated Soil Remediation 2007:** Presents soil remediation results for dock site, fuel storage and concentrate storage areas.
7. **Nanisivik Mine – Contaminated Soil Remediation 2007:** Details remediation work completed during 2007 over the entire site.
8. **Nanisivik Mine – Contaminated Soil Remediation 2008:** Details remediation work completed during 2008 and finalizing this aspect of reclamation.
9. **Human Health Ecological Risk Assessment – Review 2009:** Revisits the original study and comments on success of soil remediation at achieving objectives.
10. **Nanisivik Geotechnical Inspection Report 2008:** Annual report on geotechnical structures and geothermal conditions. Includes temporal trends on geothermal behaviour as it relates to climate and design modeling.

We trust this additional information will address the requests made at the pre-hearing conference.
