Dear Mr. Skoglund:

The Nunavut Water Board (NWB) has completed a technical review of the 2017 Annual Report submitted on March 21, 2018. On April 5, 2018, the NWB acknowledged receipt of the Annual Report and provided it to the Qikiqtani distribution list for information. No comments have been received to date.

The technical review of the Annual Report, found that the information addresses the requirements of the Licence. The NWB acknowledges the efforts made by Nyrstar to complete the closure of this site.

The NWB notes that this Licence will expire on December 22, 2019. The NWB would like to take this opportunity to remind you that:

- A Licence renewal will be required for ongoing Post-Closure Activities or Long Term Monitoring at the Former Nanisivik Mine Site;
- Licensees must obtain a determination from the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) prior to the NWB processing an Application as per Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act (NuPPAA) and amended Nunavut Agreement;
- Renewal Applications for Type “A” Water Licences typically take up to twelve months for the NWB to process.
