
Acceptance of the Initial Monitoring EEM Study Design

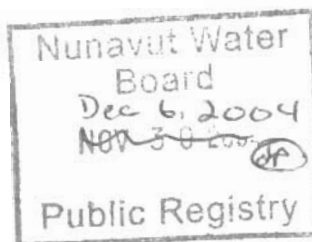
The TAP noted that the addendum addressed the comments and questions raised during review of the January 2004 Study Design submission.
