As part of the Nunavut Water Board's ongoing commitment to facilitate the Hamlet of Arctic Bay's involvement in the closure and reclamation of the Nanisivik Mine, the Nunavut Water Board intends to hold a public meeting in Arctic Bay on Thursday, April 17th, 2003.

The main purpose of this meeting will be to present information and encourage discussion concerning the following two reports that were submitted by CanZinco Limited as part of its obligations under Licence NWB1NAN0208:

- The <u>Phase II Environmental Site Assessment</u>, which describes the type and extent of contamination at the mine site; and
- The <u>Human Health and Ecological Risk Assessment</u>, which evaluates whether metal concentrations in the soils at the mine site pose a threat to the future health of humans or animals.

The meeting will be facilitated by Levi Barnabas, Arctic Bay's Community Liaison Coordinator, and I. The meeting will begin at 7:00 PM and will likely be held in the school gymnasium. All interested parties are encouraged to attend this meeting and their participation at the event is welcomed.
