The Government of Nunavut, Department of Environment (DOE) has reviewed Abandonment and Reclamation Plan, Fuel Tank Farm, Former Nanisivik Mine Site, from the Breakwater Resources Ltd., and has the following comments and recommendations to make based on the Environmental Protection Act.

The DOE has noted that the proponent will collect soil samples from the fuel tank and soil remediation facility area; however, the DOE recommends that the proponent should also demonstrate that no contamination has migrated within or outside the tank farm area.

The proponent is referred to use the attached DOE's Environmental Guideline for Contaminated Site Remediation (Updated March 2009).
