Re: Request for Amendment of Water Licence No. N4L2 - 0262 (the "Licence"), held by Cominco Ltd. (the "Licensee")

We are writing to you to request that the Licence be amended to reflect a change in the holder. Cominco Mining Partnership (the "Partnership") wishes to hold the Licence and completely assume all of the obligations of the Licensee in respect of the Licence.

We understand that because a partnership that includes the current licensee is requesting to hold the Licence, there is no need to formally assign the Licence. The name of the Licensee was changed and a Certificate of Amendment was issued by Industry Canada on 23 July 2001 certifying that the articles of the Licensee were amended to change the name of the Licensee to Teck Cominco Metals Ltd.
