I have been reminded by the water board that we haven't done a sublethal test for a few years. We are required to do this 1 time per year.
I suspect we have only days of sampling left before everything freezes or it may be too late already.

This test is very difficult due to short timelines to get samples to the lab and also I think the lab needs some special stuff to be available at the lab also.
Is there any chance we can still get this done this year?? It would likely mean we would need to test this week and rush rush the sample south.
