## **RE**: NWB1POL – Polaris Decommissioning and Reclamation Plan – Submission on Landfill Cover Cap Design for Little Red Dog Quarry

On behalf of Environment Canada (EC), I have reviewed the information submitted with the above-mentioned application. The following specialist advice has been provided pursuant to Environment Canada's mandated responsibilities for the enforcement of the Canadian Environmental Protection Act, Section 36(3) of the Fisheries Act, the Migratory Birds Convention Act, and the Species at Risk Act.

Based on the information provided, EC has no major concerns with the Little Red Dog Quarry landfill cover cap design as proposed. Environment Canada also requests clarification regarding where the course blasted limestone will be quarried from, and the volumes anticipated for use. Environment Canada recommends that the proponent install thermistors in the cover cap layer so that the performance of the material can be monitored over the long term. The proponent should be prepared to implement a contingency plan in the event that the cover material does not perform as suspected, such as the application of additional material to increase the thickness of the cover.
