Dear Mr. Netser:

This is a reminder that your permit NWB4SOU0002 for water use and waste disposal associated with a commercial caribou harvest on Southampton Island expires on June 1, 2002.

As indicated in Part E Item 2 of the permit, a summary report needs to be submitted to the Nunavut Water Board within 30 days of the expiry. This report should include information about activities for the above permit, water quality data, abandonment and restoration of the site, list any unauthorized spills and the follow-up action taken, and any other relevant water use and waste disposal information.

Please submit these reports to the Nunavut Water Board prior to July 1, 2002.

Should you wish to continue with the commercial caribou harvest activities, you will need to file an application for renewal of this permit.

An application form and supplementary questionnaire are available through the internet on our ftp site at ftp.nwb.yk.com in the folder "NWB GENERAL INFORMATION." Please note that for your renewal, you would be required to use the "Remote Camp/Exploration" supplementary questionnaire. Please mark "N/A" for any questions that are irrelevant to your situation. We prefer to get as much of the application as possible by e-mail to rbecker@polarnet.ca. Please also allow 3-4 months for the renewal process. For an application to be deemed complete the following are needed:

- completed application form
- relevant maps and drawings (maximum size 11" x 17")
- completed supplementary questionnaire
- executive summary in BOTH English and Inuktitut
- application fee of \$30 payable to the Receiver General of Canada
