The Nunavut Water Board has approved your application for the assignment of permit NWB4SOU9800 from Tunnug Harvest Ltd. to Southampton Island Meat Company. (Motion #99-19-03).

The Board has also approved an extension on permit NWB4SOU9800 until the Nunavut Impact Review Board has completed screening of this project, as permit NWB4SOU9800 expired on January 26, 2000.

In order to complete the process of the current application for renewal in a timely manner, the application fee of \$30.00 payable to the Receiver General for Canada must be submitted.

As will be indicated in your renewed permit, applications for renewal should now be filed three months before the permit's expiry date. If a permit cannot be renewed prior to expiry, the applicant should apply for an extension in the interim.
