Just wondering if you were in a position to provide any kind of an update with respect to the outstanding information needed to move forward on our screening of the Coral Harbour Quarry project (NIRB file no. 11QN041, info available here:).

Further, we were hoping that you may have some additional information on where things are at for the petroleum/fuel systems upgrades for both Coral Harbour and Baker Lake. I know we have received a water licence application for the Coral Harbour tank farm – but to conduct hydrostatic testing only – our understanding was that neither the Coral nor Baker Lake facilities had been built. Are you aware of whether we may expect to see these facilities' applications for water licenses come through any time soon?

Any updates you or your colleagues may be able to provide at this time would be great.
