Hi Amanda,

My apologies for not getting back to you sooner. The upgrade to the Coral Harbour has not yet been done. Construction on the tank farm is scheduled for this summer. There is a new tank (>80,000L) being built within the existing containment dike of the tank farm.

There is a similar situation in Baker Lake where construction is also scheduled to take place this summer of a new tank (>80,000L) being built within the existing containment dike of the tank farm. An existing tank is also being converted to hold gasoline from diesel. A water licence application for hydrostatic testing (NWB File No. 1BH-BLT----) has been submitted by the contractor on this project (Inukshuk Construction).

I am waiting on confirmation from our Regional Lands Administrator on whether or not we need a permit from the Hamlets since the tank farm capacity increase projects are not changing the existing area of the tank farms. I will inform you when I get a response.

Please let me know what is needed to proceed with any NIRB requirements and the NWB applications.

I'm following up to my previous email of April 15, inquiring about the Coral Harbour tank farm hydrostatic testing (NWB File No. 1BH-PSC----) and hoping that you can find some time to provide a quick response for Monday if at all possible.

Again, I am hoping you can advise as to whether or not the tank farm in Coral Harbour has been built, and if not, whether additional applications for land tenure etc. would be forthcoming.

If you're able to confirm that it has already been built, the NIRB will be able to issue notice that the NWB Application for hydrostatic testing is exempt from the requirement for screening and the Nunawut Planning Commission and Nunawut Water Board (cc'ed) will be able to move forward with their respective processes.

Your attention to this matter would be greatly appreciated.
