Re: Licence 1BH-PSC1414; Type "B" – Petroleum System Upgrades, Coral Harbour, Nunavut by Inukshuk Construction– Water Licence Renewal Application

Dear Mr. Losier

On September 23, 2014, Inukshuk Construction (the "Applicant") filed an Application (the Application) with the Nunavut Water Board (the "NWB" or the "Board") for the renewal of Water Licence 1BH-PSC1414. The following documentation was included in Inukshuk Construction's Application:

- General Water Licence Application
- Appendix A: aerial photos and drawings that includes:
 - -Google earth map;
 - Main Storage Facility Overall Site Plan, dwg. #01, revision C;
 - Main Site Storage Facility Existing Site Plan, dwg. #02, revision C;
 - -Main Site Storage Facility Proposed Site Plan, dwg. # 03, revision C;
- Appendix B: Project Description in English
- Appendix C: Project Description in Inuktitut

The NWB has reviewed the Application and as a result of the review has concluded that a <u>Type</u> "B" <u>Amendment/ Renewal Application</u> is needed for the proposed activities. Therefore the Board is requesting the Applicant to submit a new Application for a Water Licence Type "B" <u>Amendment/ Renewal.</u>

In addition, supplementary information is requested by the Board, and detailed as follow:

New Amendment / Renewal Application
 A new updated Water Licence Amendment / Renewal Application;

2. Description of the Undertaking (Scope of the Application)

The scope of the Application should include all the activities that will take place under this undertaking i.e. cleaning of used oil tanks and hydrostatic tests on new tanks.

3. Blocks 13, 14 and 15 of the Application

All water uses and waste generated and deposited shall be reflected on blocks 13, 14 and 15 of the Application.

4. Spill Contingency Plan

Provide a Spill and Contingency Plan according to Part H, item 1 of the current Water Licence, 1BH-PSC1414.

5. Water withdrawal and source lake storage capacity

The Applicant should provide a general assessment on whether the planned water withdrawal will impact the source lake's storage capacity (see AANDC comment's during the Licence process on February 21, 2014.

Note that the NWB may request additional information from the Applicant that goes beyond the scope of information detailed in this letter.
