The Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received Nunavut Construction Limited's "Bulk Fuel Facility Upgrade-Sanikiluaq" project proposal from Nunavut Construction Limited on May 14, 2015. The project proposal submission included the following documents:

- NIRB Part 1 Summary Application Form in English
- Map
- Business License

The NIRB conducts screening (environmental impact assessment) of project proposals upon referral from Government departments/agencies and Regional Inuit Associations responsible for authorizing the proposed project works or activities. Please be advised that it is the Proponent's responsibility to apply for all authorizations and approvals required to carry out the proposed project works or activities.

Once the NIRB receives a referral from an authorizing agency, the Board will screen the project proposal in accordance with Article 12, Part 4 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement and will report to the Government Minister(s) responsible for authorizing the project.

Further, upon receipt of the required referral, the NIRB will be undertaking a preliminary completeness check of your application. In order to ensure your application contains the minimum information required for the NIRB's screening, it is recommended that you submit the following, noting that the NIRB may request additional information at any point during the screening process:

- NIRB Part 1 Summary Application Form in Inuktitut
- Map clearly identifying the proposed activities and location

• Non technical Project Proposal summary in English and Inuktitut
