Good Day Mr Dwyer

This is James Wilson.

I spoke with Bernard Bourque. He is the Director of PPD and I have copied him in this email. He is not sure why there was an application for the construction or an expansion of the landfarm in Rankin so for now that will be suspended. Since PPD just acquired the licence for it from CGS a couple years ago they will operate it as is.

The landfarm in Baker lake is still planned but due to issues with CGS and with Hamlet we have been unable to find a suitable location to construct the landfarm on.

In the past week we have been able to identify a couple of new sites which have met with approval from SAO Sheldon Dorey who will present it to council at their next meeting. The next step is going through the process of approval from CGS lands, then we will approach the Planning Committee, NIRB followed by NWB.

The plan is to get all permissions this year and begin preparations of the site but build the actual cell next summer. All the required construction materials are in Baker lake now we are just seeking the site and all approvals.

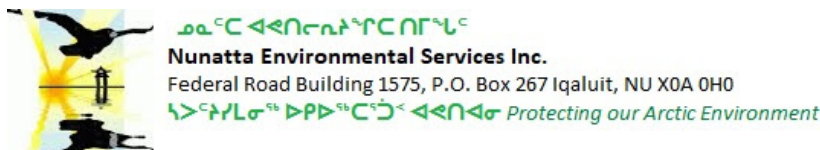
