The Nunavut Water Board (“NWB” “Board”) has reviewed the 2010 and 2011 Annual Reports received on April 11, 2011 and February 28, 2012, respectively, from Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC) for the Bear Island Mid-Canada Line Radar Station Remediation Project, located approximately 300 kilometres (km) south of James Bay, within the Qikiqtani Region of Nunavut. The review determined that the reports are acceptable and generally consistent with the reporting requirement under Part B, Item 1 in Licence 1BR-BEA1015.
