**RE: NUNAVUT WATER LICENCE APPLICATION - BATHURST/HIGH ARCTIC
REMEDICATION AND RISK MANAGEMENT PROJECT**

Please find enclosed a Water Licence Application from Indigenous Affairs and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) for the Bathurst/High Arctic Remediation Project.

We received the NPC Conformity Determination (File No. 148489) and NIRB Screening Decision Report (File No.17UN035) in March 2017 and June 2017, respectively. In addition to this application, INAC is also applying for a Land Use Permit from INAC.

The project was originally planned for completion during July to September 2017 but was deferred to 2018 due to delays which did not allow for sufficient time to complete the site work in 2017. The work is now scheduled to take place between July 2018 and September 2018. The original application package dated February 17, 2017 is included with this submission.
