RE: Submission of 2010 Annual Report for Licence No. 1BR-BYR0712

Dear Ms. Schulz:

The Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) received on April 18, 2011 from AECOM Canada Ltd., on behalf of Defence Construction Canada, the 2010 Annual Report for the PIN-4, Byron Bay Distant Early Warning (DEW) Line site project, located approximately 150 kilometers west of Cambridge Bay within the Kitikmeot Region of Nunavut. On April 20, 2011, the NWB acknowledged receipt and distributed the document to the public for information purposes. No comments have been received to date.

The review of the document determined that it is mostly consistent with the reporting requirements under the Licence 1BR-BYR0712. However, to completely satisfy all of the reporting requirements of the Licence, Licensee is advised to address the following items by July 31, 2011:

- 1. Provide information on the monthly and annual quantities (in cubic metres) of material deposited in the Non-Hazardous Waste Landfill, Landfarm, Tier II Disposal Facility and other disposal and/or treatment facilities for which this information was not provided;
- 2. Provide a summary of follow-up actions taken to prevent unauthorized discharges;
- 3. Include proposed measures that will ensure that effluent criteria are met prior to discharge; and
- 4. Remove all references in the Monitoring Report that relates to the FOX-2 (Longstaff Bluff) site;

In addition to the above-listed items, the Board is requesting for due diligence purposes that asbuilt drawings, signed and stamped by an engineer authorized to practice in Nunavut, be submitted for all facilities that have been constructed, to date, under the Licence.
