Re. Request for Emergency Amendment to Water License 1BR-CAP0914

Dear Richard,

E. Grubens Transport Ltd. is presently in contract with Department of National Defence (Defence Construction Canada) for The Cleanup of PIN-2, Cape Young Dew Line Site, Nunavut, which commenced in summer of 2009. A water license was acquired in October 2008 to extract water from the Harding River, which is located approximately 10km South of the main camp. This water source was utilized in the fall of 2009 and was expected to be sufficient for the remainder of the contract to take place during summer 2010 and summer 2011. Unfortunately, due to seasonal melting and other unknown factors, the Harding River is temporarily undesireable for use as general camp water due to the abundance of silt material, etc in the water.

Upon investigation, an alternate source (identified as water source #2) exists in a fast flowing creek approximately 4km South of the camp. This alternate source is much more acceptable and has been identified as a historical water source for the site. Since our present potable camp water is supplied in bottles, this alternate source would be appropriate for general camp use such as ablution/latrine facilities and cleaning.

This request for an emergency amendment is critical for the overall operation of the camp. We presently have 44 personnel onsite and our work season is highly restrained by time. Please consider this request as soon as possible.
