Dear Mr. Bellizzi:

Defence Construction Canada (DCC) has submitted a Water Licence Application to amend Type B Water Licence 1BR-CAP0914 (Licence) to change the water source. Documents pertaining to this application are available from our ftp site (username *public* and password *registry*).

On the basis of urgent circumstances, DCC has requested the Board review the Application and amend the Licence accordingly. The Board has reviewed the request, and accepts DND's submission that urgent circumstances exist, as per DCC's letter dated August 4, 2010.

Accordingly, pursuant to subsection 55(4) of the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act*,<sup>1</sup> the Board approves a shorter notice period for this Application and intends to act on the Application on August 16, 2010.

By copy of this letter to the distribution list and the enclosed notice of application sent to the council of the municipality or municipalities most affected by your application, we invite interested persons to make representations directly to the NWB within 10 days from the date of

<sup>1</sup> Subsection 55(4) of the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act* states:

55(4) Where a public hearing is not held in relation to an application, the Board shall not act on the application until at least thirty days notice of the application that has been published under subsection (1) unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are urgent circumstances that justify the Board acting on that application in a shorter period, but that shorter period shall not be less than ten days.
