Hi Megan,

Thee following concerns must be addressed before the Application can proceed:

- 1. Status of construction of the landfarm expansion: A Status Report submitted to the Board October 1, 2013, states that the contractor, based on visual observation, had apparently built the landfarm per design. Is this the landfarm design based on the original specifications, or the landfarm design that encompasses the proposed expansion? It is important to note, commencing construction without having the appropriate conformity, project assessment and regulatory authorizations in place is not permitted under the Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act, S.C. 2002, c. 10. If construction of the expanded landfarm design has indeed concluded, it is important that the Licencee submit a Final Construction Report, including construction dates and signed, as-built drawings, so the project can be be adequately assessed.
- 2. The Amendment Application indicates that the upgraded landfarm will cover an area of 2500 m2 to accommodate 450 cu.m. of contaminated soil. However, the 2013 Annual Report indicated that 698 cu.m. was deposited in the landfarm. This seems to suggest that even after the upgrade the landfarm will operate in excess of design capacity. If this is not the case, the Proponent should elaborate on the design capacity of the landfarm. Also, the executive summary indicates that the upgraded landfarm will cover an area of 2500 m2, whereas the application mentions 2400 m2 of HDPE liner (Section 15). Is this an error, or does the liner cover less area than the landfarm design?
- 3. Contact for the Licence: I have Mohammed Ansari as the contact for CGS-GN on the licence. Is this still the proper contact to have on file for this licence?
- 4. The Licencee must update the O&M Plan, the A&R Plan and the Spill Contingency Plan with the current dimensions and design capacity of the landfarm, as well as an updated map of the install area.
