Technical Review Memorandum

Re: 1BR-CIL---- New Type B Water License Application – Chesterfield Inlet Landfarm – Government of Nunavut

Background

The Hamlet of Chesterfield Inlet is located on the Western Shore of Hudson Bay approximately 100 km northeast of Rankin Inlet. The landfarm will be located in the Hamlet of Chesterfield Inlet adjacent to the current solid waste municipal landfill.

The landfarm is being constructed to accommodate 170m³ of type B contaminated soil only from the Hamlet's tank farm. The landfarm area will be bermed and lined and will occupy an area of 750 m², having a capacity of 380 m³.

Recommendations/Comments

Application

AANDC recommends that all relevant leases, permits, conformity checks and screenings as well as any other authorizations are in place and proper approvals received before any work commences. AANDC notes that the appropriate approvals from the Nunavut Planning Commission and Nunavut Impact Review Board were not received or available prior to Stantec submitting the renewal application.

Operation and Maintenance Plan

Section 1.3 Community Information

AANDC would like to point out what appears to be a typing error in this section. In the 4th paragraph the proponent states that "The Government of Nunavut in consultation with the Hamlet of Rankin Inlet selected the site". AANDC believes



that this should read "The Government of Nunavut in consultation with the **Hamlet of Chesterfield Inlet** selected the site".

This sentence is the same in all three plans (Operation and Maintenance, Spill Contingency and Abandonment and Restoration).

Spill Contingency Plan

AANDC notes that the contact number for AANDC listed in the Spill Plan is for the Northwest Territories. AANDC recommends changing that number to reflect the AANDC Nunavut contact numbers, which are as follows: Manager of Field Operations of the Department of Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development (formerly INAC) Tel 867 975 4295 or Fax 867 975 6445. These numbers should be included in the spill plan as well as all other applicable plans associated with the project and subsequent water license, if approved.

Abandonment and Restoration Plan

AANDC is satisfied that the abandonment and restoration plan contains all pertinent information and have no further comments at this time.
