On July 4th, 2014 an inspection was completed of water licence no.1BR-CIL1217 by Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada's Field Operations division. The report detailed that the undertaking was not currently triggering the Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act. On October 31st, 2017 the water licence expired and was not renewed as the proponent determined it unnecessary for the current activity.

Based on the findings of the July 4<sup>th</sup> inspection and the information provided by the proponent, Field Operations division has determined that this will be a final inspection by Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada. However, Field Operations division will continue to inspect activities that may use or may impact water through the powers of the Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act.

Community and Government Services is cautioned that they are required to act in accordance with the Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act and all other applicable legislation while conduct such activities.
