Hi Richard

Following up on our conversation, the site is requesting a temporary open burn of our daily camp waste until new parts arrive for the camp's incinerator. The parts are being ordered from Edmonton following mechanical breakdown of the incinerator's motor yesterday. The camp has been operating this year since June 15 and we have been burning solid camp waste daily as outlined in our Water Licence and Land use permit.

Our primary concern is that we have seen two bears lingering around the outskirts of camp this past two weeks and would like to continue to burn our camp waste daily as a matter of bear deterrent.

The next plane scheduled for the site is Monday.
