The Nunavut Water Board (NWB) received on July 7, 2009 the Sewage Disposal System drawings and details, Non-Hazardous Waste Landfill for construction drawings and additional information to the accepted Remedial Action Plan entitled "PIN-B - Clifton Point PHC Contaminated Soil Remediation Plan", dated May 1, 2009. The above documents were distributed for information on July 23, 2009 and there have been no comments received by the NWB with respect to the submission.

An internal review has determined that the Non-Hazardous Waste Landfill drawings submitted are sufficient for construction purposes. The Licensee is reminded that, under Part H, Item 1 of the Licence, detailed designs/drawings that are signed and stamped by an engineer are required to be submitted at least ninety (90) days prior to the construction of the Sewage Disposal System and Landfarm.

The PIN-B Clifton Point PHC Contaminated Soil Remediation Plan received on July 7, 2009 has been accepted by the NWB subject to the following. Discharges of effluent from excavated areas referred to section 3.1.2 are considered under Part D, Items 13 and 15 and shall meet discharge criteria or be classified as hazardous waste for disposal offsite. The Licensee is requested, as provided for under Part B, Item 1(r), to submit monitoring data for effluent discharged from the excavated areas in all future annual reports.
