Dear Ms. Plato and Mr. Spagnuolo:

The Nunavut Water Board ("NWB") received on March 29, 2010, from Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC), Contaminated Sites, the Plan entitled "Site Specific Spill Contingency Plan Clifton Point PIN-B Cleanup," revised March 26, 2010. On September 21, 2010, the NWB acknowledged receipt of the Plan and distributed the document to interested parties and persons for a thirty-day (30) public review period. By October 21, 2010, the date on which the comment period ended, submissions were received from a number of parties. ¹

The NWB staff review the Plan, while simultaneously considering the submissions received, and determined that the document is consistent with the requirements under of Part I, Item 1 in Licence 1BR-CLI0914. The NWB has, therefore, approved the Plan under 2010-18-L01.

The Licensee is encouraged, however, to consult the comments received from the respective parties.
