Contwoyto Lake Former Weather Station Remediation Project is complete. No long term monitoring is required as all hazardous and non-hazardous materials were removed from the site.

8. ABANDONMENT MEASURES

The following measures have been taken to address the final abandonment conditions required by the licence: (explain, with drawings, how abandonment conditions of the licence have been met; how stream channels have been rehabilitated; how tailings have been recontoured; how instream structures have been removed; and how waste materials have been disposed of. As per Section III (J) General Conditions, Abandonment and Restoration of the NWB Licence 1BR-CLR1419, the abandonment measures followed the methods described in the *Contwoyto Lake Former Weather Station Remedial Action Plan* (SENES, 2013). All hazardous and non-hazardous materials and wastes were removed from the site and disposed of in appropriate facilities in Yellowknife or Alberta. All areas that were excavated to remove materials and debris were filled using local borrow materials and graded to match contours of the site. No instream structures were used. The 2015 final annual report to NWB provides details about the final site inspection and includes photographs (see attached report, *2015 Annual Report Remediation of the Contwoyto Lake Former Weather Station, NU Prepared for Nunavut Water Board, Arcadis* (2016).
