Erik, As per our discussion, please be advised that the main reason for having the 3.5 years term for the water license (with an expiry of December 2016), was because major construction and remediation activities including the construction of landfill, landfarm and site roads, and excavation and treatment/disposal of impacted soils will be concluded in December 2016, with most of the water usage requirement during that time. The long term monitoring including the groundwater monitoring will continue for the next two years to September 2018 anticipating that there won't be much need for water usage during these activities. However, based on our discussion, Please include the long term monitoring time period in the water license and have the water license term extended to 5.5 years up to September 2018.
