Executive Summary and Report

This report to the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) is submitted as required by water licence 1BR-CRO1111 – Type “B”, Part B. General Conditions, paragraph 1.

PIN-1BG is an unattended (unmanned) North Warning System radar site located at Croker River, Nunavut. The site is visited quarterly for preventive maintenance inspections and as required for other work by Nasittuq staff based out of the Logistics Support Site – Inuvik (LSS-I), Inuvik, Northwest Territories.

The fuel storage tanks at the beach and summit locations of PIN-1BG were cleaned and inspected in 2011. The original plan was to set up a small temporary camp on- site during the project. However, when the project occurred, more flights were made available and no camp was set up. The water licence was not exercised.

Four drums of tank cleaning waste were sent for disposal at a licensed hazardous waste disposal facility outside of Nunavut. The drums were sent to Clean Harbors, Box 390, Ryley, AB, T0B 4A0.
