The Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) has completed a technical review of the 2017 and 2018 Annual Report submissions for the above stated Water Licence. On April 17, 2018 and April 18, 2019, the Board acknowledged receipt of the respective 2017 and 2018 Annual Reports and made them available to the Kitikmeot distribution list for information. No comments have been received to date.

The technical review of the Annual Reports determined that the information provided generally addresses the requirements of the Water Licence. The Board appreciates submission of such detailed reports.

The Board notes that the post-construction as-built plans and drawings developed for the Cambridge Bay Soil and Water Treatment Facility (Submission) were submitted to the NWB on December 29, 2017. On January 08, 2018, the Submission was provided to the interested parties for information. No comments have been received to date.

By copy of this letter the Board acknowledges that the Submission addresses the requirements of Part H, Item 4 of the current Water Licence.

Additionally, the NWB notes that the 2018 Annual Report indicates that the Water Monitoring Plan will be revised once the groundwater monitoring wells are sampled for the first time in 2019. The Board strongly recommends that the Licensee consult the comments submitted by the ECCC¹
