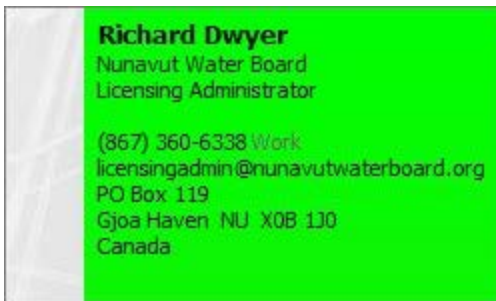

As this project was not previously assessed under the new *Nunavut Project and Planning Assessment Act* (NuPPAA) you will need to apply to the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) for them to make a determination whether or not the project will be exempt from NIRB screening.

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has completed its review of the above noted project proposal. The activities associated with this proposal were previously reviewed by NPC, and a conformity determination was issued on [October 29, 2008] which still applies. In addition, the activities were previously screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB FILE NO.: 08YN074, August 11, 2008). Related Nunavut Water Board files numbers are 1BR-CUL0708 and 1BR-CUL1118. This project proposal is exempt from the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act* (NUPPAA) under section 235 of that Act. The above-noted project proposal is exempt from screening by the NIRB because the NPC is of the understanding that it does not change the general scope of the original project activities, and the exceptions noted in Section 12.4.3 (a) and (b) of the Nunavut Agreement do not apply.
