Pursuant to your letter dated April 2, 2020 and Part K, Item 4 of Water Licence 1BR-CUL1828, please accept the following as the proposed Thermistor Monitoring Program for Cullaton Lake:

- 1.) The 4 Tailings Pond No 1 dry cover thermistors installed in 2018 will be recorded every second year, starting in 2020, in conjunction with the biennial water quality monitoring program. The thermistor monitoring program will continue for the term of the present license.
- 2.) A review will be conducted in the final year of the present license and recommendations for future monitoring will be included with the license renewal due in 2028.
