Hi Tamara:

The Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) has completed its preliminary review of the above-mentioned application in which it was determined that the following items must be addressed/confirmed before the application could proceed to the next stage of the licensing process:

- 1. Details on the amount of water required for sampling should be provided. Previously, Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada's Inspectors did not necessarily consider water use associated with site monitoring activities as active use; however, the Inspectors' approach has changed since the implementation of Nunavut specific Waters Regulations. Water used for monitoring purposes must be included in any licence issued to a project.
- 3. Confirmation on whether for-construction drawings for site facilities will be submitted instead of drafts contained in the monitoring plan accompanying the application.
