The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

- 1. Amendment of water license 3BC-DYE0919 for continued operation and maintenance of the DYE-M North Warning System site.
- 2. Summary of modification: New field testing of water berms and the addition of a landfarm for on-site remediation of hydrocarbon impacted soils.
- 3. Related NIRB FILE No.: 03DN124.
- 4. Locations: Qikiqtani [Cape Dyer, Approx. 150 km south-east of Qikiqtarjuaq]

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has determined that this project proposal is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan. The Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) previously screened the works and activities associated with the current proposals, including operation and maintenance of the DYE-M North warning system site (NIRB FILE No: 03DN124).

The NPC has determined that the above-noted project proposal is a significant modification to the project because of the inclusion of a hydrocarbon landfarm.

The above-noted project proposals require screening by the NIRB under section 12.4.3 of the Nunavut Agreement as amended because of the addition of a component or activity that was not part of the original proposals and their inclusion is a significant modification of the project.
