UMA Engineering Ltd. is pleased to submit this annual report as per the requirements of Part B.1 of water use license NWB5DYE0409. The report was prepared on behalf of Defence Construction Canada and the Department of National Defence.

Due to the late mobilization of equipment and materials to the DYE-M site in September, the work in 2004 involved the construction of the camp facilities and setting of survey control points in preparation of the 2005 season.

The work plan for 2004 will be to continue with the clean up activities as described in the project description. An overall site plan is included to show the locations of the various work areas described in this report.

The camp was operational for one month. In that time, approximately 100 cubic metres of water was extracted from the middle site water use lake. Approximately 80 cubic metres of effluent was discharged into the sewage lagoon; no samples were collected.

There were no spill incidences at the DYE-M site in 2004.

There were no community meetings held prior to the start of the 2004 season; however, the contractor has planned meetings for April 5-8, 2005, prior to the start of work this year.
