The Nunavut Water Board ("NWB") received on March 29, 2012 the 2011 Annual Report for the above-mentioned project as a requirement of Part B, Item 1 of the current licence. The report was forwarded to the distribution list for information.

The submission is found to be meeting the reporting requirements of the licence. Monitoring results indicate that the waste water discharge and sewage-effluent discharge criteria are generally met. However, the causes of sporadic high levels of Faecal Coliforms in the sewage effluent should be studied and identified. In addition, the NWB appreciates the inclusion of photographs to help aid in the understanding of the activities that have taken place.
