Sewage from the camp was released to the west of the camp while the hose was thawed. The contractor thawed the hose K which allowed flow to the lagoons by May 29th. The area impacted by the release will be assessed after snow removal and sewage residue will be removed and disposed of in the Sewage Lagoon.
