The Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development (DIAND) are submitting the enclosed water use application for the clean-up of the former FOX-C Intermediate DEW Line Site. Please find enclosed two copies of the application and supporting documents.

In 2004, DIAND completed site investigations at FOX-C under Land Use Permit Number N2004X0025, Water Licence Number NWB5EKA0406, an Inuit Owned Land Access Permit and a Nunavut Planning Commission approval. Due to a significant change in scope, a new application for the remediation activities is being submitted. It is expected that all existing approvals will be replaced by the new permits.

In addition to applying for a Water Licence, DIAND is also applying for a new Land Use Permit and Inuit Owned Land Access Permit.
