RE: How to deal with Grey & Black Water during Camp Setup at Ekalugad Fjord

Mr Thompson,

To deal with the Grey and Black Water at QC proposes that a Sump be dug shortly after QC's Staff is mobilised. All grey water from kitchen activities can be drained into the sump. A toilet can be constructed over the sump to collect all black water waste. The sump will be dug using an excavator that is already on this site. If the ground is frozen we will use a hydraulic hammer to break it up prior to excavation.

We plan to have the following personnel on site during the camp setup:

- Site Superintendent
- QC's Engineer
- 3 Operators
- 2 Labourers
- Electrician
- Plumber
- Mechanic
- 2 Cooks
- PWGSC Representative
- Helicopter Pilot & Engineer

QC anticipates that it will take approximately 10 days to complete the Camp and Lagoon setup.
