Sarah,

I just wanted to clarify something with you. The list of approved activities on our current water license includes construction camp mobilization and operation, road construction and maintenance, and sampling activities associated with site assessment and contaminant delineation activities on the FOX-C DEW Line site. All of the activities for the first week or two on-site will be camp set-up and road construction and maintenance. However the contractor has also identified that landfarm and landfill construction are supposed to occur in June as well. These activities consist of the excavation of clean fill to construct the aforementioned facilities so there would not be any handling of contaminated soil. If the contractor wants to start this on-site before we get the new water license (which I recognize is unlikely), can we authorize him to proceed? Please advise. Thanks.
