**RE: WATER LICENCE APPLICATION – ENNADAI LAKE REMEDIATION
PROJECT**

Dear Ms. Beaulieu:

Please find enclosed a Water Licence Application from Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC) for the Ennadai Lake Remediation Project.

The Ennadai Lake Remediation Project is located approximately 380 km west of Arviat (the nearest community) and 500 km southwest of Rankin Inlet, Nunavut, at approximately 61° 07' 51" N latitude and 100° 53' 14" W longitude. The site was a weather station as of the 1950s. It was operated either as a manned or unmanned station, at different times since its inception and was abandoned in the late 1980s to early 1990s.

The Ennadai Lake Remediation Project consists of thirteen buildings, five large above ground storage tanks (ASTs), pipelines (including one overhead), an unmaintained airstrip, trails, five drum caches, several upright and laying metal towers, a main debris area, and several small debris areas.

In addition to a Water Licence, AANDC is applying for a Land Use Permit from Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada and an Access to Inuit Owned Land Permit from the Kivalliq Inuit Association. This application package includes:
