The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has completed its review of the above noted project proposal. It conforms to the Keewatin Regional Land Use Plan (KRLUP), subject to the enclosed questionnaire.

The NPC is forwarding the project proposal application form with this determination to the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) for screening. The applicant has undertaken to comply with the enclosed questionnaire requirements. The authorizing agency to which this letter is addressed is responsible under the *Nunavut Land Claims Agreement* to implement any of the enclosed requirements by incorporating the requirements directly, or otherwise ensuring that they must be met, in the terms and conditions of any authorizations issued.
