General Background Information on the Project (*optional):

The Ennadai Lake site was a former weather station, located approximately 370 km west of Arviat (the nearest community) and 500 km southwest of Rankin Inlet, Nunavut, at approximately 61° 07' 51" N latitude and 100° 53' 14" W longitude. The site was developed in the 1950s and was operated both as a manned and unmanned station, at different times since its construction and was abandoned in the late 1980s to early 1990s.

Remediation activities at the site were undertaken between 2014-2015, and included the construction of a non-hazardous waste landfill (NHWL), demolition and disposal of onsite structures, and clean-up of hazardous materials and contaminated soil.

As per departmental commitments to monitor the NHWL post-closure, a 25-year long term monitoring (LTM) program was initiated at Ennadai Lake in 2016 and includes visual inspection, groundwater sampling, soil sampling (as required), and natural environment monitoring. Refer to the *Ennadai Lake Long Term Monitoring Plan* (2016) for more details.

Year 1, 3 and 5 of the LTM Plan took place in 2016, 2018, and 2020 respectively. Future events are scheduled for 2022, 2025, 2030, 2035, and 2040.
