RE: NPC File # 149274 [FOX-3 Dewar Lakes Landfill Monitoring Program]

The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

- 1. Summary of proposed activities: Renewal of Type B water license 1BR-FOD1320 for the continuation of the landfill monitoring program at FOX-3 Dewar Lakes former DEW line site. The landfill monitoring activities consist of making visual observations, collecting soil and groundwater samples, and downloading temperature data from thermal monitoring instruments.
- 2. Related NWB File No: 1BR-FOD1320, Related NIRB FILE No. 07DN069 & 12DA002.
- 3. Location: Qikiqtani Region; [Former FOX-3 Dewar Lakes Dew Line Site; approx. 315 km West of Qikiqtarjuaq, and 230 km south of Clyde River]

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has completed its review of the above noted project proposal. NPC has determined that this project proposal is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan. The activities associated with this proposal were previously reviewed by NPC on November 26, 2007. In addition, the works and

activities listed above were previously screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB FILE No. 07DN069 and 12DA002). The above-noted project proposal is exempt from screening by the NIRB because the NPC is of the understanding that it does not change the general scope of the original or previously amended project activities, and the exceptions noted in Section 12.4.3 (a) and (b) of the Nunavut Agreement do not apply.
