Defence Construction Canada have applied for an amendment to their current licence to allow an additional 5 extra people on site this summer to do an assessment. They plan on being there for about 2 weeks to 2.5 weeks. I've attached their application and the current licence for your review. I don't believe that an amendment is required since they will not go over their allowable water use of 2 m3/day. There does not appear to be any additional waste generated while in camp.
