On March 27, 2012 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received extension and amendment requests from Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC) for Defence Construction Canada's (DCC) "FOX-4, Cape Hooper Site Remediation" which was previously screened by the NIRB (File No. 10DN038). The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) confirmed on April 10, 2012 that the previous terms and conformity determination still apply.
