The Nunavut Water Board ("NWB") acknowledges the receipt of the above Reports under Part B, Item 1 of Licence No.1BR-FOX0713.

The technical review of the Annual Reports has been completed. The Board has taken into consideration the information submitted and hereby accepts the above Annual Reports. During the review of the Reports the following issues were identified and will need to be corrected in all future annual reports;

- 1. The Licensee shall measure and record in cubic metres the daily quantities of water utilized for all purposes at the intake of the Water Supply Facility;
- 2. The translated executive summary shall briefly discuss all plans, reports or studies conducted under the Licence;

The NWB notes that there is increasing staining and seepage points at some of the landfills. The Annual Reports also identify some debris that has become exposed in the landfills. The NWB requests to be informed of any remediation actions taken to address these issues.
