### **Recommendations:**

#### **General:**

1. The EWG questioned the need for the extra samples that ESG asked the contractor to take. What is the purpose of these samples and what was requested?

#### **Helipad Landfills – East and West:**

2. The EWG recommends that these two landfills be monitored again in 2011 due to the fact that contaminant concentrations have an increasing trend.


#### **Barrel Dump:**

3. The EWG recommends that this landfill be monitored again in 2011 due to the fact that contaminant concentrations have an increasing trend.

#### **Airstrip Landfill:**

4. The EWG recommends that DCC assess the potential for this channel to stabilize and self-armor thereby allowing drainage to find its natural course. This assessment should take place in 2011.
5. The EWG requests that DCC provide the EM/MAG surveys completed at the Airstrip Landfill (if available) so that the NTI representatives can review the potential impact of this erosion channel.
